The visiting hours are from 10am to 6pm daily and admission is free.

Dear Guests,

Welcome to The Andaman Beat, your guide to what's what around the resort. The concierge has shared many of their very own favorite destinations around the island with me and I must say that so far my favorite place will have to be the top of Gunung Raya Mountain, which is the highest peak on the island giving spectacular views of this most mythical island. A huge benefit of driving up this mountain is that you get all the views as you would with the cable car, but without the entry fee! Additionally, it is home to a large number of Great Hornbills, which are the largest birds on the island.

Measuring a whopping 1.2m from the tip of its beak to the tip of its tail. I'm still always amazed at the 'whoosh whoosh' sound made by their giant wings when they fly by. The Great Hornbill shares 'monogamous' trait with another large bird on the island, the White Bellied Sea Eagle, and as we have seen some very nice wedding celebration recently, I thought I would share a great 'Wildlife Wedding Story' as told to us by our very own resident naturalists here in the resort. Over the years that our naturalists has been on the island, they had the privilege of seeing the wedding ceremony of these birds on very few occasions. Why so few you might ask? As these birds are monogamous - they pair-off for life so you do not see too many wedding ceremonies, only once in a pairs lifetime. This bird reaches maturity at year five and can live for about twenty-eight years.

When it is time for a young male to pair off, he will find a potential mate and chase her. His job is to catch her, so he relentlessly chases her while her job is to not make it easy for him. If he is unable to catch her he is probably too young or not strong enough. But if he is strong, fast and firm he will come close to her, he will try to get directly above her, and he brings his talons down towards her - and she turns over to fight him off. But after many attempts at fighting him, she is now too tired and eventually relents by giving her talons to him. Now unable to flap their wings, the pair spin-fall in a most beautiful slow spiral dance, and just before they reach the top of the trees they let go and fly. She then joins up with him and they fly off together into the sunset! Very romantic, don't you think?

CALL OF THE WILD

The Colugo, or Cynocephalidae, is a truly unique animal. Found exclusively in the rainforests of South East Asia the Colugo lives its entire life up in the trees. It sleeps during the day and becomes active at night, waiting until just after sunset to make its first flight of the day. Often referred to as a Flying Lemur, the Colugo is not actually a lemur, but its own unique species. It has a membrane called a Patagium which stretches all around the body, from the neck, to the hands, feet and tip of the tail. This Patagium allows the Colugo to glide up to 70 metres through the canopy. They can even change direction, and can be seen 'banking' around trees to find their preferred landing spot.

Colugos are mammals, and are the closest surviving species to Primates. Newborns weigh in at a whopping 35g, and live closely attached to the mother until about 6 months old. They diet mainly on vegetation in the trees, generally eating very little, therefore taking up to 3 years to reach maturity. The Colugo is very prominent around The Andaman, best seen gliding over the swimming pool or around the Beach Bar
